Designed to test an individual's ability to recognise and understand international safety symbols. Candidates are presented with a variety of question styles including matching descriptions to images and multiple choice questions.

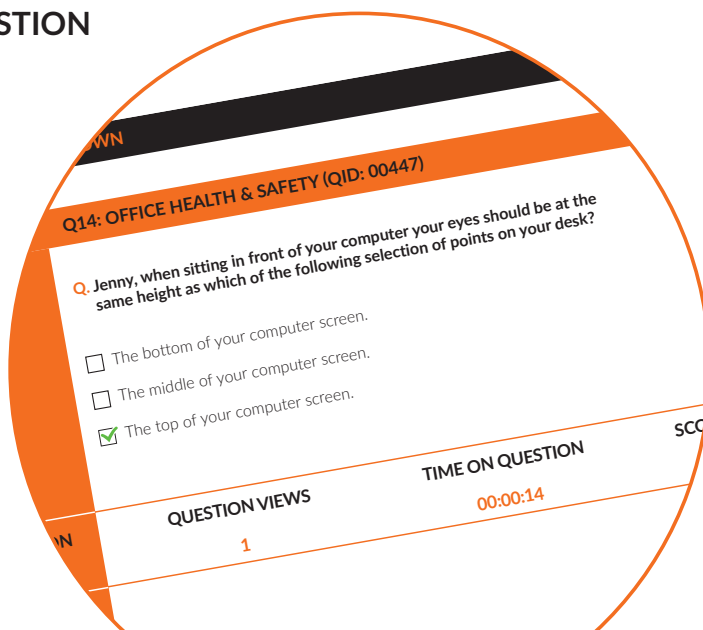
